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### Day 1 – Depart USA to Israel

Your journey begins as you depart the United States on your international flight to Israel.

### Day 2 – Arrive Tel Aviv

Arrive into Tel Aviv. You will be met by an NTS representative and transferred to your hotel for overnight.

### Day 3 – Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Gamla Lookout, Golan Heights, Boat Ride, Jordan River

Begin your journey of a lifetime today as you visit Caesarea Philippi, where Peter exclaimed, "You are the Christ" (Matt. 16). View Gamla, known as the "Masada of the North," where Jews held out against the Roman armies in 67 AD, and where many perished when the Romans ultimately overran the almost impregnable fortress/city. Travel through the Golan Heights and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel. Enjoy a boat ride on the waters of the Sea of Galilee. Enjoy time at the Jordan River for baptism before returning to our hotel.

### Day 4 – Nazareth, Nazareth Village, Cana, Mt. Tabor, Mt. of Beatitudes, St. Peter's Primacy

After enjoying the Israeli buffet breakfast, visit Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matt. 2). While there we will visit Nazareth Village depicting the way of life that our Lord lived as He grew up. Visit Cana, site of the Lord's first miracle (John 2), and view Mt. Tabor where Barak fought Sisera (Judges 4) and which is the traditional site of the transfiguration (Matt. 17). Return to Tiberias and see the Mt. of Beatitudes, the traditional site where Jesus preached His



Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5 – 7) and St. Peter's Primacy where the Lord ate breakfast with the disciples after His resurrection (John 21).

### Day 5 – Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Caesarea (aqueduct and Hippodrome), Western Wall, Jerusalem

Today we say goodbye to the Sea of Galilee and begin our journey south to Jerusalem. Visit Megiddo and the Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16). Find the remains of Caesarea by the Sea along the coastline of the Mediterranean. It was here that Cornelius the Centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa (Acts 25 and 26). Enter the holy city of Jerusalem and proceed to the Western Wall where we spend time in prayer. Check into our hotel in Jerusalem.

### Day 6 – Model City, Bethlehem, Pilate's Judgment Hall, Lithostrotos, Via Dolorosa

Observe the outstanding Model of Jerusalem as it was during the Roman occupation. It will help us understand what the city looked like during the time of Christ. St. Peter in Gallicantu is now a church commemorating the place where our Lord was beaten the night before He was crucified. Visit Bethlehem where Jesus was born (Luke 2). See Pilate's Judgment Hall in the remains of the Fortress of Antonia. Walk the Via Dolorosa.

### Day 7 – Upper Room, Mt. Zion, Jewish Quarter, Temple Mount, Pool of Bethesda, Mt. of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Dominus Fleuit, Pool of Siloam

First stop in the Upper Room (Acts 2) near the traditional site of the disciples transforming experience. Continue to the Jewish Quarter, still preserving remains of the Roman destruction of Jerusalem almost 2,000 years ago. Visit the Pool of Bethesda (John 5). Take in a panoramic view of the Holy City from the Mount of Olives and continue to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed (Matt. 26). Stop and see Dominus Fleuit, the traditional site where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19). After our visit to the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9) we will return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

### Day 8 – Masada, Dead Sea, Sodom and Gomorrah,

Enjoy a visit to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod and famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable



car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. On our return way to Jerusalem, stop at the shores of the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth. Further south is the area of what is thought to be where biblical Sodom and Gomorrah was once located.

**Day 9 – Davidson’s Visitor Center, Rabbi’s Tunnel, Yad Vashem, Garden Tomb, Gordon’s Calvary**

Our last full day of sightseeing in Jerusalem might very well be our most memorable. We will make our way to the Davidson Center amongst the Southern wall excavations. Then we will go underground and walk through the Rabbi’s Tunnel – part of the Western Wall temple complex that has been recently excavated. Here we can see stones from Herod’s time that are over 400 tons in weight. Visit Yad Vashem (Holocaust) Museum for a somber reminder of the horrors of the holocaust with the purpose of never allowing this portion of history to repeat itself. Sense the agony of Christ’s crucifixion at Gordon’s Calvary (Luke 23) and experience the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb. After enjoying our final dinner in Israel, prepare for our departure back to the USA.

**Day 10 – Arrive in USA**

Today we arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish.
